What is a Hybrid Course Curriculum?

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A hybrid course curriculum is a combination of both private sessions and Group Team Training.

What are the benefits of a hybrid course curriculum?

Private Sessions

Your first 3 of 5 classes are mandatory private sessions that allow for more personalized attention and instruction; and a more customized training plan that addresses your dog's specific needs and challenges (particularly beneficial for dogs with anxiety, aggression, or other behavioral issues and concerns). Plus, without distractions, your Pup can learn at his own pace and make faster progress in preparation for a smooth transition to group classes for socialization and distraction training.

Group classes

Your Week 4 & 5 group team training classes offer valuable opportunities for your Pup to learn & practice how to focus on cues and behaviors amidst distractions from other dogs and pet parents, as well as playing & interacting appropriately with other dogs and people; aiding in socialization, building confidence, and fostering a sense of community among fellow pet parents.

With a hybrid approach, pet parents are more likely to find success starting with private sessions to address specific issues and then transitioning to group classes for socialization and distraction training.

Remember, your Pup is ALWAYS doing the best he can in the environment he has been put in with the education he has been given. It's that simple! So don't ever let anyone tell you otherwise! When we know better, we do better! The only shame is choosing NOT to do better when we know better, so let's do better together!
